Graduate nursing classes taken outside of the Fort Riley curriculum through online delivery will not be eligible for this scholarship. Students who receive full tuition benefits from any combination of sources will not be eligible for the University of Mary Military Scholarship.

Military students will be billed tuition charges at the University's stated rate. The student will receive a scholarship equal to the difference between the University's stated tuition rate per credit and the military rate per credit (based on no more than the NDNG tuition assistance rate.)

For applicants receiving Post 9/11 educational benefits: Federal Tuition Assistance and/or University of Mary scholarship will reduce tuition. Post 9/11 benefits will pay the applicable amount of the remaining tuition balance. Please contact the school certifying official in the Military Student Services Office at milservices@umary.edu with any questions on Post 9/11 educational benefits.

Military scholarships apply only to tuition. The military student will be responsible for all other charges and fees. The Military Scholarship Application must be completed and signed by the enrolling military student, and returned to: **Office of Financial Aid, 7500 University Drive, Bismarck, ND 58504.**
