

Nursing Faculty - Traditional Program (2 positions)

The University of Mary Nursing Division seeks qualified applicants for two full-time teaching positions in the traditional baccalaureate program beginning fall 2018. The successful candidates will have a strong ability and desire to teach. One position will provide theory and clinical instruction in medical/surgical nursing and the other in pediatric nursing in addition to teaching in supportive nursing courses. Primary responsibilities include classroom and lab/clinical instruction. Candidates must have a strong clinical background. Salary is commensurate with qualifications, experience, and rank.

The successful candidates will understand, support, and advance the liberal arts, excel in teaching, and promote the program to the community at large.
