

Occupational Therapy Faculty Position (Fargo, ND)

The University of Mary Doctorate Program in Occupational Therapy invites applications for a 2 full-time faculty positions beginning in fall 2018. The positions will be at the University of Mary, Fargo, ND campus. Preferred areas of teaching expertise include neurology, orthopedics, and geriatrics or pediatrics; however, other areas will be considered. The successful candidate is expected to teach in the professional program, supervise students in the on-campus pro bono clinic, develop a scholarly agenda, participate in service activities (school, university, and professional), advise undergraduate and graduate students, and maintain currency in clinical practice. Salary is commensurate with experience and qualifications.

The University of Mary is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association. The Occupational Therapy Program is accredited at the Candidacy level for the OTD by the Accreditation Council for Occupational Therapy Education (ACOTE).

Required Qualifications include:

- 5 years of clinical practice in the US
- Occupational therapy degree
- Licensure or eligibility for OT licensure in North Dakota and Montana
- Preference will be given to applicants with an earned academic doctoral degree (PhD, EdD or DSc preferred) in occupational therapy or a related discipline and prior academic teaching experience
- A willingness to support and advance the Christian, Catholic, Benedictine mission of the University of Mary
- Supporting the ongoing implementation of *Ex Corde Ecclesiae*, the apostolic constitution on Catholic colleges and universities
- Building a culture of ready and earnest hospitality throughout the university in accord with Saint Benedict's admonition that all be received as Christ
