Welder Library has nearly 75,000 visitors each year, seats 204 students, and has 30 computer workstations. The library collection has over 50,000 print volumes, more than 350,000 eBooks, over 3,500 multimedia items, and databases providing access to over 60,000 journals. Library materials are searchable through an online catalog. Welder Library provides interlibrary loan access to library collections nationwide.

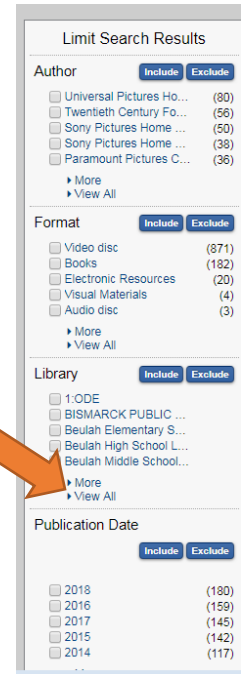

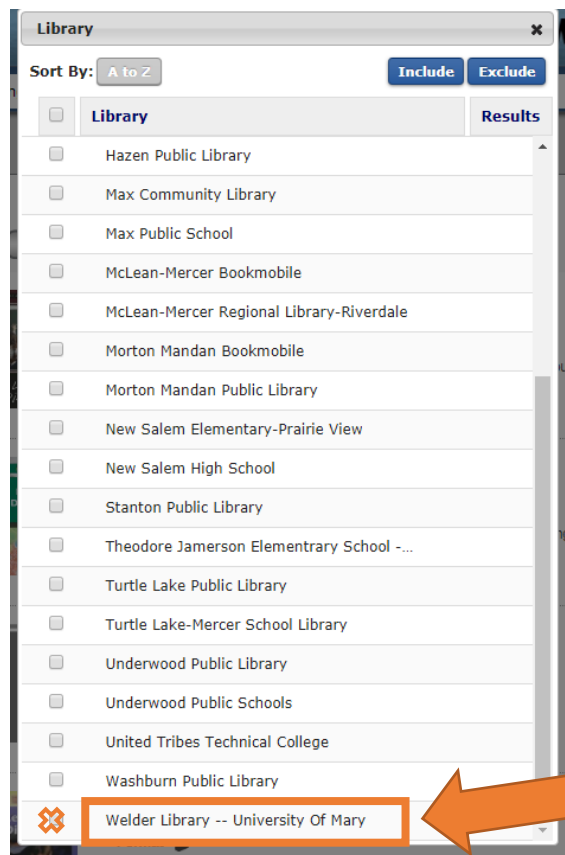

Welder Library is a member of the Central Dakota Library Network consortium. This allows us to borrow books from other area libraries. To narrow your search results, use the limiting tools on the left side of the page. You can use the limiting tools to sort by format, publication date, and subject in the same manner as listed in step 3 and 4.

**Step 3:** To see what is available only at Welder Library, click on “View All” under the library heading.



**Step 4:** In the popup window, select Welder Library –University of Mary. You may have to scroll down to see Welder Library at the bottom of the list. Then, click “Include” at the top.



**Step 5:** Click on the title of any item to learn more about it. By doing this, you can find the shelf number of where the item is located in the library. You can also see the status of the item.



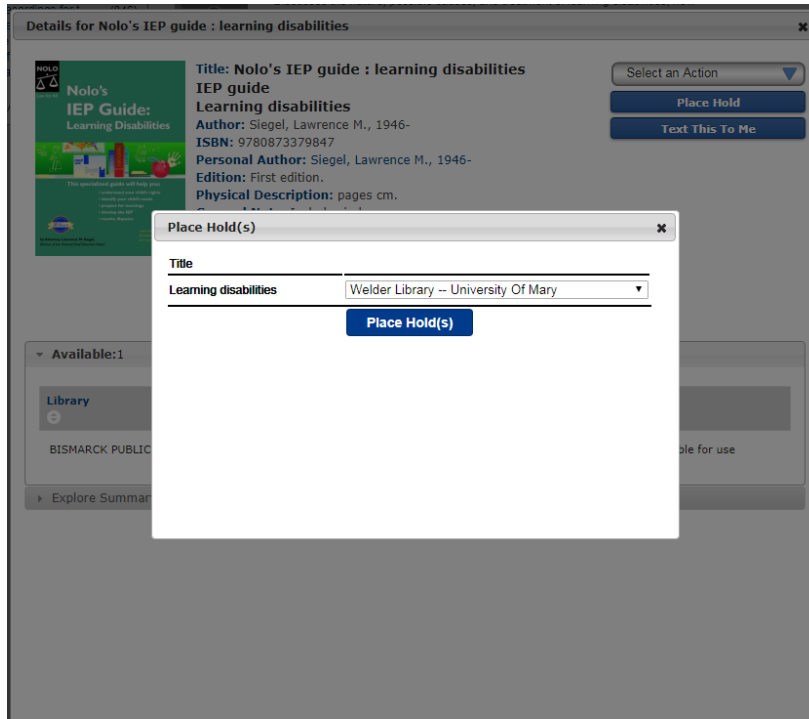




