**TIME ZONE DIFFERENCES:** Italy is on Central European Time (CET), which is 7 hours *ahead* of Bismarck, Central Standard Time (CST). For example, if it is 12:00pm CST in Bismarck, it is already 7:00pm CET in Rome; noon in Bismarck is mid-evening in Rome.
