Saint Scholastica Hall for women is an intentional discernment community shaped by a covenantal life infused with love of our Benedictine Sisters of Annunciation Monastery.

The women in this living learning community will support each other in virtuous living through study, prayer, service, and in recreational activities. Located on the third level of Roers Hall, Saint Scholastica features rooms for upper-level students. Residents will participate in planning community activities to support, build, strengthen, and build community life.

In addition to the General Eligibility Requirements for participation in the University of Mary Residence Life Program, students must meet the following additional requirements to be eligible:

1. Residents in Saint Scholastica Hall must have successfully completed a minimum of 24 credits at an accredited college or university, a minimum GPA of 2.5, and a student conduct status at or below Level 2.
2. Residents of Saint Scholastica Hall must purchase a meal plan from an approved list of options.
3. Through written application materials and an interview, applicants should indicate a willingness to grow in faith and to be a positive and active member of the Saint Scholastica Hall community.
