COURSE TRANSFER GUIDE

Mary College at ASU courses fulfill ASU general studies requirements and count towards scholarship renewal and financial aid eligibility. ASU general studies requirements are binding on all baccalaureate degree-seekers. Through Mary College courses, ASU students can fulfill requirements for the Humanities (HU) core area, as well as all three awareness areas: Historical (H), Global (G), and Cultural Diversity in the United States (C). Our courses also fulfill religious studies, philosophy, and general elective requirements.

ASU Degree Requirements

Humanities (HU) Core Area

All ASU baccalaureate students must earn at least six lower-division credits with a (HU) designation.

University upper-division requirement*

Students may fulfill three of their upper-division credit hours requirement with an upper-division course with a (HU) designation.

Historical Awareness (H)

All ASU baccalaureate students must complete one course with a (H) designation.

Cultural Diversity in the United States (C)

All ASU baccalaureate students must complete one course with a (C) designation.

Global Awareness (G)

All ASU baccalaureate students must complete one course with a (G) designation.
