Academic Advising Guide for **Economics Students**



The **Civic Leaders Fellowship** is a unique, semester-long opportunity for all full-time, undergraduate students at the University of Mary to join fellow scholars for intellectually rigorous leadership formation at **Arizona State University's School of Civic and Economic Thought and Leadership** (SCETL). This fellowship is open to full-time undergraduate students at Mary — but especially those studying business administration, philosophy, politics, or economics.
